Course overview	Many students in special needs schools (physically handicapped education area) suffer from brain diseases. This course will enable students to analyze the current situation about the problem that is increasingly complex in the field of education for children with physically disabilities, and then organize and study the basic and practical issues in association with the creation and assessment of "class."
Remarks	The course will request a mandatory practice teaching of special needs class at the Kirigaoka Special Needs School. The class time of practice teaching may be different from the regular class time of this course.
