Course overview	The course will enable students to understand the needs of the medical and nursing care from physical characteristics of the elderly and learn about the outline of long-term care insurance system. Then, while actually experiencing the process of nursing care, the students will be able to deepen their understanding of the roles and duties of care workers and learn about the differences from and/or cooperation with other workers.
Remarks	The course is specified as a prerequisite subject for the examination of national certified social worker. It is preferable that students take the Lecture on Welfare for the Aged together. The course is equivalent to CE31231 in FY2012 or earlier. Details will be informed later.
Teaching method	Lecture
Attainment target	Students will be able to learn about physical characteristics of the elderly, the outline of long-term care insurance system, objective, function, scope, and basic skills of care works.
